

Rule 375-3-1-.22. Disposition of DUI Citation

- (1) Court copy-- The ~~D~~driver's license ~~to~~ shall be attached to the court copy and forwarded to court having jurisdiction.
- ~~(2) Department of Driver Services copy-- This is sent to the court with the court copy.~~
- (32) ~~Issuing~~ Department of Driver Services copy-- This copy shall be forwarded to the Department of Driver Services within ~~15~~ ten (10) days of issuance.
(3) Citations may also be sent to the Department of Driver Services electronically through Georgia Electronic Conviction Processing System.
- (4) Violator's copy-- This copy is given to the violator.
- (5) Officer's copy-- This copy will be kept in the issuing agency's file to issue a duplicate copy if needed.

SYNOPSIS

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE OF PROPOSED RULE

The purpose of this amendment is to make sentences grammatically correct and to align the rule with the applicable statute.

DIFFERENCE BETWEEN EXISTING AND PROPOSED RULE

In section (1), we added "the" and "shall" where needed to make the sentence read correctly. Section (2) was deleted because it was unnecessary. Section (3) became the new section (2) and we corrected the number of days law enforcement has to send the citation to DDS. The new section (3) was added to account for electronic submissions. In section (5), "the" was inserted where needed for the sentence to read properly. The duplicate of "Authority" was deleted and a code section (40-5-69) was corrected to 40-5-67.
