

Rule 375-5-6-.31 Pending Charges Against Owners and Instructors

- (1) ~~If at the time of application application, the~~ If the applicant is charged with any offense that a conviction for which would result in said applicant's ineligibility for certification if convicted, consideration of the application shall be ~~denied~~suspended until the disposition is provided. ~~entry of a plea or verdict or dismissal of said charge.~~
- (2) ~~If, after the issuance of a permit~~ certification, a person is charged with any offense ~~that for which a conviction for which would result in said applicant's ineligibility for~~ Certification, the Certification permit ~~may~~shall be suspended pending disposition of such charge. If the person is convicted of such charge, the Certification~~permit~~ shall be revoked.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The purpose of this amendment is to make the rule clearer.

DIFFERENCE BETWEEN EXISTING AND PROPOSED RULES

Paragraphs (1) and (2) were rewritten to eliminate excessive wording. In paragraph (1), "suspended" was replaced with "denied" because no certification exists to suspend in this paragraph. In paragraph (2), "permit" was replaced "Certification" so the proper terminology is used.
